As you read through the passages answer the following questions (*as they apply*):

- 1. What do you observe about Peter through his actions, words, responses, and reactions?
- 2. As you track Peter's journey, his life develops in a way similar to that of a character arc, like those seen in movies, novels, and stories. What minor and major developments in his character, faith, calling, or purpose do you notice over time?
- 3. Identify themes, truths, or principles about God's work in and through an individual that emerge from a particular reference or build across multiple references.
